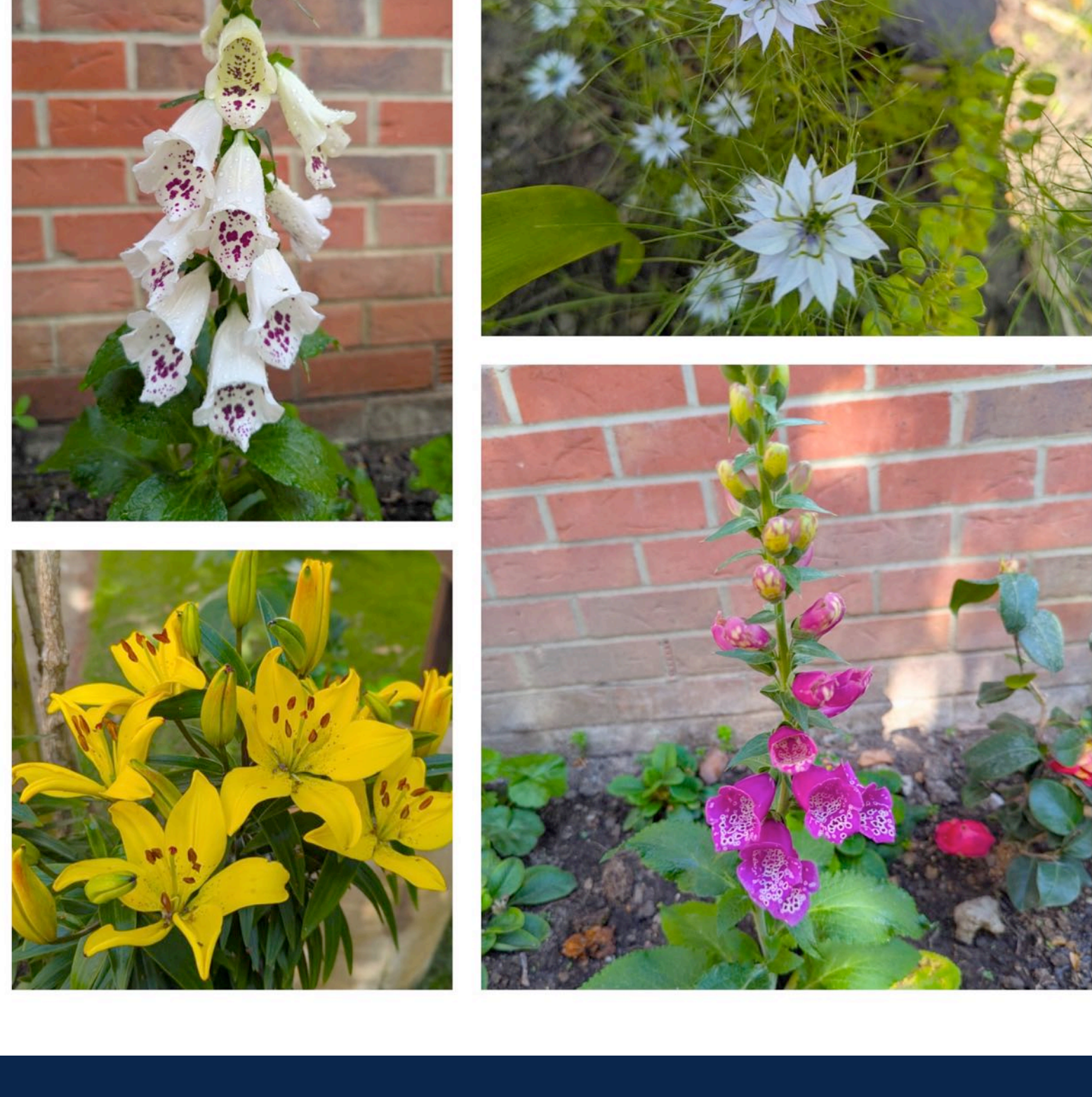
The biscuits looked wonderful, and judging by the smiles at tea time, they tasted just as good.
